Services Provided

The Day Services Department of The Resource Center is comprised of both site based and community based programs. Site based programs offered at 5 different locations offer a variety of services and supports to help people develop skills and obtain the life they want.

Staff support is provided to help people with daily life activities, skill development and achieving satisfying and rewarding connections and relationships within their community. Day Hab Without Walls provides opportunities for volunteering, improving one's own skills and socialization, and discovering all that is available within the community.



Admission Criteria/ Eligibility Requirements

A person can be admitted to Day Habilitation services if he/she is age eighteen or over and has a developmental disability with a diagnosis of intellectual/developmental disability, autism, cerebral palsy, epilepsy, or neurological impairment, and possesses a deficit in adaptive behavior.

Each person must also have the capacity to participate in planned activities at a site other than his/her residence. Only people whose functional, developmental, and nursing needs can be met by the service can be admitted. People must be enrolled or eligible for enrollment in the Home and Community Based Services Waiver program. Preference will be given to residents of Chautauqua County.
